- Infection control procedures apply ٠
- Wear suitable protective equipment, especially gloves ٠
- Ensure the person's privacy and dignity •
- Often, sputum (phlegm) is collected in the morning although not always ٠
- Sit the person up, make them comfortable
- Firstly, wash their mouth out with water (not mouthwash) to prevent any • contamination of the sputum
- Spit the water out into a bowl and wipe their face so it is clean
- ٠ The client expectorates - coughs up and spits out sputum (phlegm) - into an appropriate sterile sample pot
- Have paper tissues available for them to wipe their face after expectorating
- Make sure the client is comfortable •
- Immediately, seal the specimen pot lid and label the specimen container ٠ appropriately
- Put the specimen container into a specimen bag for transit to the relevant place for testing
- If it has to be stored in a refrigerator, only use a refrigerator specifically for storing samples in
