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Infection control procedures apply •

- Wear suitable protective equipment, especially gloves •
- Ensure the person's privacy and dignity •
- Stoma bags vary, follow manufacturer's instructions •
- Assuming the bag can be emptied first, the following applies •
- Empty the bag appropriately and dispose of waste according to your procedures ٠
- With one hand, hold the stoma in place using the other hand to carefully remove • the adhesive tape that holds it in place
- Using warm water, soap and damp cotton balls, clean the area
- Rinse and dry thoroughly with paper towels •
- ٠ All cleaning items into clinical waste
- Check is the skin in good condition? •
- ٠ Change gloves
- Using the stoma template, cut a hole into the new flange/bag
- Carefully, place the new flange/bag over the stoma making sure it is a firm fit
- Make sure the bag fits properly •
- Ensure the client is comfortable •
- Have the client wash their hands
- Waste material should be disposed of according to safe practice
