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Infection control procedures apply ٠

- Wear suitable protective equipment, especially gloves •
- Ensure absolute privacy and dignity •
- Put the commode in the right place next to bed, wheelchair etc. ٠
- Are commode, wheelchair wheels etc. locked? •
- Where possible, adjust the bed to the height of commode etc. •
- Using the correct method, help the person transfer to the commode •
- Make sure they are appropriately dressed to keep warm
- ٠ Whether you stay with the person or not is determined by their choice, assessment etc. and recorded in the care plan - you must follow the care plan
- Check, have they finished using the commode?
- ٠ When they have finished, encourage them to clean themselves, helping where necessary using the correct methods
- Wash their anal and/or genital areas •
- Dry them properly
- Empty the commode according to your internal procedures ٠
- The commode receptacle should be sterilised, preferably in an appropriate steriliser
- Using hot water and an appropriate cleaning agent, wash the commode chair •
- Rinse it and dry it with paper towel
- Finally, wipe the commode chair with an appropriate disinfectant •
- Note: CoSHH procedures apply
